

Artist Sheila Humphries

Mrs Sheila Humphries is a Noogar elder, acclaimed artist, story teller and educator. Her work has been displayed internationally and is included in the Guinness Book of World Records as the largest piece of Aboriginal artwork.

WA Eye Specialists principal surgeons Dr Johnny Wu and Dr Tze Lai were privileged to care and perform cataract surgery for Mrs Humphries in the early 2000s. Mrs Humphries drew two paintings for WA Eye Specialists, one to tell her story of the vivid colour and details she could see and appreciate after bilateral successful cataract surgery. The second art piece depicts the story of all the major international hospitals Dr Wu and Dr Lai performed eye surgery across four continents in Europe, North America, Asia and Australasia before their establishment of WA Eye Specialists in Perth, Western Australia.
